2007 National Training School LEVEL I

The Tennessee Burglar & Fire Alarm Association has scheduled eleven National Training School (NTS) Certified Alarm Technician Level I courses in Tennessee in 2007.

Level I training consist of twenty-four hours of intensive instruction. A multiple choice exam is given at the end of the course; students must pass this test to be designated a "Certified Technician - Level I."

The Alarm Systems Contractors Board now requires that all sales, service and installation employees complete the NTS Level I or equivalent training. All new employees will have one year to complete the NTS Level I or equivalent training.

On-the-job training and self-taught technicians are a thing of the past. Ordinances are cropping up daily around the country requiring licensing of alarm companies and technicians, and concern is being voiced over the professionalism of those in our industry. Electricians must be certified for their jobs, as must plumbers and others. Certified installers provide credibility for your company. Trained people mean faster installation with less mistakes, fewer false alarms, fewer service calls, better referrals and a more professional interface with your clientele.

The total investment for the course per student is \$312 if your company is a member of the TBFAA or another chartered chapter of the NBFAA -- or \$512 if not. That breaks down to less than \$12.00 per hour for personal training from some of the top professionals in our industry -- and it's tax deductible. U.S. Treasury regulations permit an income tax deduction for educational expenses, including registration fees, travel, meals, and lodging when attending.

You'll need to make your own lodging reservations. Classes will be 9:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. on Friday, 8:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday. We must have at least 20 students to have the class, so please register as soon as possible.

<u>ALL STUDENTS</u> must be registered and paid <u>two weeks</u> prior to the date of the class to hold a seat. If you must cancel, a notice must be faxed or mailed to the TBFAA office 72 hours prior to the class or you will not receive a refund. YOU WILL NEED A PHOTO ID!
