

AFAA Launches New Fire Techs of the Future Scholarship Program

The AFAA Board of Director's approved a new scholarship program to support the next generation of fire alarm technicians. A \$1,000 scholarship will be offered annually to one or more students currently studying fire alarm technology at a post-secondary institution. The scholarship is open to all students registered in a post-secondary associates degree or program equivalent with a concentration on fire alarm technology related courses. To apply, the student must submit a transcript of their academic grades and a letter application summarizing their current studies, extracurricular activities and involvement with and career plans in the fire alarm industry.

The deadline for submittal is January 1st.
