Over \$112 Million Donated to Non-Profit Organizations

DMP Employees Surprised with \$5,000 Bonus to Recognize Their Generous Contributions

Among the employees of Digital Monitoring Products, generosity is important — so much so that it's one of their company values. It has also been their motivating force behind Project100,

launched in 2019 with the goal to give away \$100 million in time and money to non-profit organizations by the end of 2025.

A big goal to be sure. But last month, CEO and President Rick Britton announced that Project100 was not only achieved but surpassed. A full four years early, DMP collectively has given more than \$112 million in donations and 10,000 hours of volunteer time to non-profit organizations.






